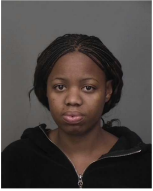

### Brief Description of Incident:

On 10/13/09 at about 840am, Utica Police responded to a call for shots fired at Steuben and Leah Streets. Upon arrival, they found a male party shot in the hand. He was taken to St. Elizabeth's where he was treated and his girlfriend was taken to police headquarters to be interviewed about the incident. After further investigation, she was charged with attempted murder and criminal use of a firearm. A firearm was recovered and the investigation is continuing. The male was identified as Casey Stuckman age 42 of Utica.
