Brief Description of Incident:

On October 28th, 2009 at approximately 2304 hours, Officers assigned to Special Operations Unit along with the New York State Police conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of Whitesboro St. and Kernan Ave. During the stop, routine inquiries were made and it was determined that the operator of the vehicle, Kashif Shepard was driving with a suspended license. The officers then determined a passenger in the vehicle, Sedrick Henderson was on parole and a person of interest in an unsolved robbery. While interviewing Henderson, a sawed off, defaced shotgun was located on his person.
