Brief Description of Incident: On Saturday, February 27, 2010 at about 3:55 pm, Officer James Holt of the Special Operations Unit, conducted a motor vehicle stop at the intersection of Bleecker Street and First Street after observing a traffic violation, with the assistance Officer Serif Seferagic of the Patrol Division. Upon further investigation it was learned that the passenger Alagujuan White provided a false name to Officer Holt and was taken into custody for false personation and an open warrant for harassment 2nd. During the arrest White was found to be in possession of a quantity of Marihuana and “Crack” Cocaine.

Wright was taken into custody without incident and held for court arraignment.
