Brief Description of Incident: On Thursday, March 18th, 2010 at about 6:56 pm, the Utica Police Department received a call that a male walking in the 1200 block of Court Street was approaching people and attempting to sell pills.

Officer Philip Dalton of the Special Operations Unit and New York State Trooper Dominic Pedulla, who were working together as part of Operation Impact, located Jordan Turner, who fit the description from the caller and attempted to speak with him. A brief foot pursuit ensued and Turner was taken into custody without further incident. Upon Turner's arrest he was found to be in possession of Hydrocodone and it was learned that he had two active warrants with the Utica Police Department.
