Brief Description of Incident:

On Monday, March 22, 2010 at about 7:25 pm Officer's Howard Brodt and James Holt of the Special Operations Unit observed a vehicle commit a traffic infraction on the cities west side. The officers attempted to conduct a vehicle stop on Whitesboro Street, when the operator failed to comply and a vehicle pursuit ensued. The operator who was identified as Gary Ryan pulled into a driveway in the 900 block of Churchill Avenue where he was detained. Officer Philip Dalton also of the Special Operations Unit arrived to conduct a DWI investigation and found that Ryan was intoxicated. Based on this investigation Dalton attempted to take Ryan into custody, when he resisted arrest. Following a brief struggle and after being exposed to a Taser, Ryan was taken into custody without further incident.
